Manitoba Jobs Agreement(MJA) Update #3 December 10, 2025

Following ECAM's November 25, 2025, update regarding the Manitoba Jobs Agreement (MJA), we are providing members with additional information.

As noted last week, the MCAM and ECAM Boards convened two joint Special Meetings with broad representation from mechanical, electrical, and subcontractors across both unionized and open-shop sectors. These sessions involved a detailed, line-by-line review of the MJA. The objectives were to identify opportunities to influence current and future versions of the agreement, clarify outstanding questions, highlight gaps, and outline concerns impacting open-shop contractors, union contractors, and the broader industry.

ECAM recognizes the sensitivity of this public policy across industry sectors and remains committed to the most effective path to advance meaningful change. MCAM and ECAM have completed a joint association briefing for the Department to influence policy development. This briefing may be found [HERE](#). In addition, ECAM representatives met with Honourable Mintu Sandhu, Minister of Public Service Delivery and his team, on December 5.
