Manitoba Prompt Payment Adjudication Authority

Government anticipates the Authority will be in place and operational by April 1, 2025. A proposal for funding has been submitted to the provincial government for inclusion in the upcoming provincial budget in support of this initiative.

Public Utilities Board Orders Increase in Auto Insurance Rates for 2025/26

Manitoba Public Utilities Board (PUB) rejected MPI's Application for a rate increase of 3.0%, and ordered an overall 5.7% rate increase to universal compulsory automobile insurance premiums for the 2025/26 insurance year, effective April 1, 2025. Read more HERE.
