The Board meets monthly September through June and is served by standing committees, advisory councils and working groups.

Builders' Liens Act Modernization Committee Update

Executive Director, Ramona Coey is representing the Mechanical & Electrical Industry on the Minister's Builders' Liens Act Modernization Committee. The committee is meeting biweekly over the next year to conduct a comprehensive review of the Act. The review will consider the Law Reform Report of 2018, recent changes to Manitoba legislation, and comparable statutes in other Canadian jurisdictions. The Executive Director recommended issuing a survey to members to identify key pain points related to the Builders' Liens Act.
