Why You Should Join the Electrical Association of Manitoba

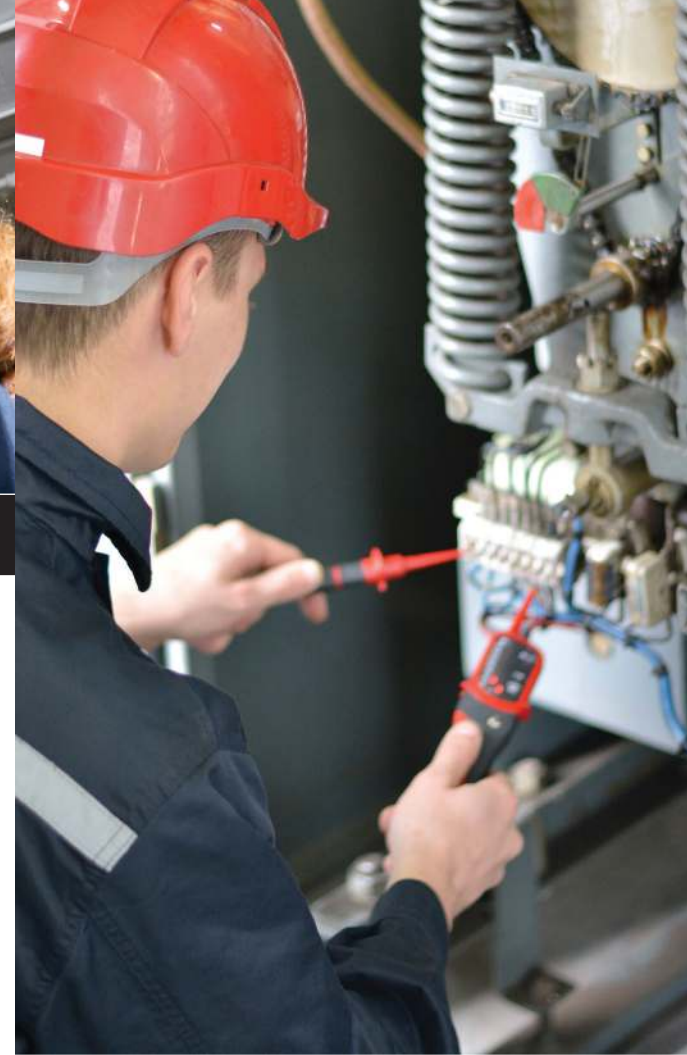
The Electrical Association of Manitoba is the voice of professionals in the electrical trade and associated industries. Through our efforts, our members enjoy many benefits, including:

Formerly the Manitoba Electrical League, the Electrical Association of Manitoba Inc. began as The Electrical Service League in 1957 (26 member companies), providing service to its members and promoting the Red Seal Wiring Program. In 1991/92 it amalgamated with the Manitoba Electrical Association (MEA) to form the Manitoba Electrical League Inc. In June 2014 the name was changed to Electrical Association of Manitoba with a tag line, "Strength in Connection."

The organization's new name is more representative of the broader range of services and benefits the Association now offers, including stability, strength and professionalism in the promotion and educational training of the electrical industry.
