In June of 2021, she ended up being hospitalized for 147 days. Against all odds, Amber is recovering well, despite having to re-learn her motor skills after losing them.

All that Amber has ever wanted was to spend Christmas in Hawaii. We were able to make her wish come true! Amber, her mom, dad, and sister all went to Hawaii for Christmas, where they spent lots of quality time together as a family.
